EQUIPMENT DROP OFF & PICK UP

TUESDAY AND THURSDAY ICE SESSIONS FROM 7:45am -8:45am

STORAGE/DROP OFF

- Students start at the arena on TUESDAY and THURSDAY.
- Students can arrive in gear for their ice times or get changed in assigned rooms. We are on the ice at 7:45 am. Please be on time.
- A storage trailer will be available to put bags into if early equipment drop-off is needed. It will be parked and unlocked outside the arena by 7:00am on Tuesday and Thursday. We are hoping Salmon Arm Ian Gray GM will graciously be providing us with the use of their trailer for the program. Please open doors with caution and care.
- An access code to the trailer will be provided to parents who need to drop off their child's equipment early. The CODE will be communicated to the parent group through an email.
 - After the ice session students will be able to put the equipment into the trailer for storage and I always lock it up as I'm the last one to leave the arena for our group before returning to the school.

STORAGE /PICK-UP

Parents may take their child's equipment after practice if they choose.

- Students will be able to place their equipment in the storage trailer outside the arena after the ice sessions.
- Parents will have the access code to the key and will be able to pick up their child's equipment at any point throughout the day. I usually replace the coded lock box with a PERMANENT lock on the trailer on Thursday at 8:00pm for the weekend. Please get your child's gear before then. Please be sure the trailer door is closed and locked and the key is returned to the lock box.
- DO NOT LEAVE GEAR in the trailer OVERNIGHT or on the WEEKENDS.

Please communicate with Mr. Gecse if other arrangements need to be made. I do not want equipment transportation issues to be a concern for a child in being unable to participation in the on ice times
