# **Expectations**

The spring rugby season is an introductory experience for the Gr. 6/7/8 into the game and laws of rugby through playing flag rugby and then into SEVENS rugby

There are many tactical and technical rules in rugby, including player safety. Attendance at practices and games is an integral part to player development, player safety, and to supporting the team. It is expected that players attend all practices and games as part of their commitment to the team and themselves. It is expected that Mr. Gecse will receive ample notice (at least one day) if a player is unable to attend a practice or game.

Equipment:

Players need the following:

- A) Mouthguard- optional/recommended (Mr. Gecse has them for \$5)
- B) Black shorts
- C) Cleats (soccer)
- D) Water bottle
- E) Sports bag to pack supplies in/ garbage or waterproof bag to keep dry from rain.
