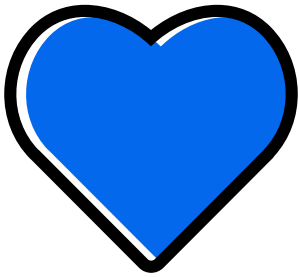


# PARENT GUIDE FOR ONLINE LEARNING



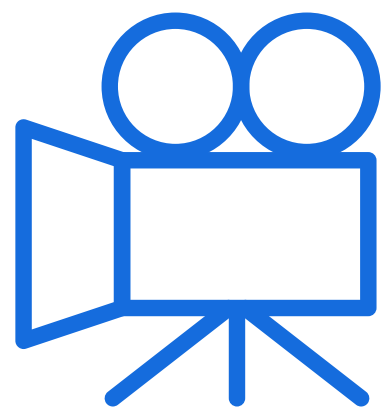
## **BE PATIENT**

We are all new to this. Be patient with your child, yourself, and teachers as we make our way through this new way of teaching.

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## **TRANSPARENCY**

Assume that you are always being recorded. Be aware of what you say and do. Always check to see if your camera is on, check your background, and mute your audio when not talking.



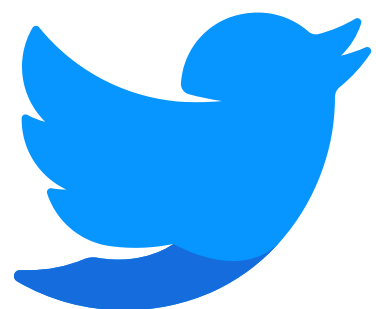
## **COMMUNICATION**

Stay in contact with your child's teacher. Let them know how the learning is going. Don't be afraid to ask questions or for help. Teachers are there to support both you and your child.

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## **SOCIAL MEDIA**

Never share a video or image of an online class on social media without everyone's knowledge and consent. Remember to be respectful and mindful of other people's privacy. A simple rule of thumb is if you are in doubt, don't share.



## **LOCATION**

Try to provide a space for your child that is free from distraction and interruptions. With multiple children this can be difficult. Ask your teacher for suggestions on how to engage younger siblings in the learning experience.
